

Information to Foreign Citizens Traveling to Albania

Who can enter Albania without a visa?

Individuals that can enter the Republic of Albania without a visa should bear the following documents when accessing the country:

I. US citizens -- with Passport / Green Card

II. Individuals that can enter Albania without a visa due to the visa liberalization regime of their country with Schengen states:

Mexico* -- with **Passport**

Panama* -- with Passport

III. Citizens of third countries, for example citizens from the Dominican Republic, can enter the territory of the Republic of Albania if:

- a) they are holders of a multiple entry Schengen visa, already used to access one of the Schengen area countries, or have a valid permit of stay from one of the countries of the Schengen area;
- b) they are holders of a multiple entry US visa, already used to enter the US, or have a valid US green card;

In case the afore mentioned individuals plan to stay in Albania for a period longer than 90 days within a period of 6 months, they must be issued an Albanian D visa.

How to get pets into the territory of the Republic of Albania

The rules and regulations for the transportation of pets into the territory of the Republic of Albania are the same as the EU rules and regulations on this issue.
